- Skills to cover
 - Watch me
 - Sit
 - Down
 - Stay
 - Wait
 - Leave it
 - Loose leash walking
 - Recall/come
- Troubleshooting areas like
 - Play nipping
 - Housetraining
 - Jumping
 - Crate training
- Classes - 7 weeks long
 - Puppy Basic Obedience - ages 8 weeks to 8 months /5:30 PM - 6:30 PM
 - Adult Basic Obedience - over 8 months/6:45 PM - 7:45 PM
 - First week of class is an orientation (no dogs permitted to attend this week)
 - Classes are held inside but outdoor activities/lesson may occur (weather permitting)
 - Include cost
- Requirements
 - All owners must show proof of the dog's current vaccines (distemper/parvo, rabies, bordetella (kennel cough) - dogs without current vaccines will not be allowed in class.
 - Dogs must be current on flea/tick treatment
 - Dogs with fleas will be required to leave class, must be treated and inspected prior to joining the class

Week 4:

- Review of skills -
 - Watch me
 - Sit
 - Touch
 - Down
- Cover -
 - Stay (sit & down position)
- Introduce tables
- Practice loose leash walking

Week 5:

- Review (using table) -
 - Watch me
 - Sit
 - Down
 - Stay
- Cover -
 - Leave it
 - Wait
- Practice loose leash walking (adding commands)

Week 6:

- Review -
 - Sit
 - Down
 - Stay
 - Wait
 - Leave it
- Cover -
 - Recall
 - Distractions with stay & wait
- Practice loose leash walking (tables & commands)

Week 7 - Graduation:

- Review of skills -
 - Watch me
 - Touch
 - Sit
 - Down
 - Stay
 - Wait
 - Leave it
 - Loose leash walking
- Introduce tricks -
 - Spin
 - Twirl
 - High five
 - Shake
- Introduce agility equipment
- Diplomas

*Remember: Training doesn't stop after this class. Training your dog and building its obedience and socialization skills is ongoing throughout the dog's life! Continue to work with your dog on a regular basis and look into more classes for your dog.
